## Project Summary:

The Yurok Tribe is soliciting proposals from qualified Engineering Services. The Yurok Tribe was funded for an USDA Emergency Community Water Assistance grant to design an extension of the existing waterline across the Weitchpec Bridge to residents 1.4 miles down the Highway. This project will add to the new water main a community center, store, church and four residences. Ductile iron pipe will be hung from the Weitchpec Bridge with hanger brackets and rollers.

Indian Health Services worked on the project designs and the construction bids came back over the amount of the funding. Due to the lack of funds for the project, the Yurok Tribe would like to submit to the USDA-RD as a 306c application.

The Yurok Tribe is soliciting bids for the update of documents for USDA Rural Development approval and subsequent funding. This includes; and updated Preliminary Engineers Report, an updated cost estimate, and a full NEPA document. The previously submitted NEPA was a simplified version required for emergency funding. **\*\*\*Engineering Firm Invoices cannot be paid until the project is funded by USDA Rural Development\*\*\*.** The current version of the PER document is available on the Yurok Tribe's Planning Department website in the "RFP" section.

**Submittal Requirements:** All submittal requirements must be submitted to the Yurok Tribe Planning Department by **10:00 A.M (P.D.S.T.) on July 5<sup>th</sup>. 2017.** Proposals must be submitted as a hard copy.
